

## **College of Education BTchLn(Hons) Scholarships for Academic Excellence**

These scholarships were established by the College of Education to reward students who have achieved academic excellence at the 200 and 300 level BTchLn or equivalent courses in primary or early childhood education and are entering the full-time BTchLn(Hons) programme.

1. The scholarships shall be known as the College of Education BTchLn(Hons) Scholarships for Academic Excellence.
2. Two scholarships shall be awarded annually to students intending to enrol in full-time study towards a BTchLn with Honours degree, following completion of a BTchLn in the Primary or Early Childhood Education programmes.
3. The scholarships shall be awarded upon academic merit assessed on the basis of candidates' 200 and 300 level courses for the BTchLn, with Professional Practice profiles from the final year of the BTchLn to be used as a deciding factor where candidates are of equal academic merit.
4. Each scholarship shall be tenable for one year and be taken up in the year following application.
5. The scholarships shall be awarded by the University Council, on the recommendation of a selection panel comprising:
  - a) The Dean of the Faculty of Education or nominee;
  - b) The Associate Dean (Early Childhood Teacher Education) or nominee;
  - c) The Associate Dean (Primary Teacher Education) or nominee;
  - d) The Co-ordinator of the BTchLn programme or nominee.

If in any year the Council determines that there are not two candidates of sufficient merit, it may award only one scholarship or make no award.

6. The scholars may not hold any other scholarship or award that comprises payment of tuition fees.
7. The Council may, on the recommendation of the Academic Board, withdraw a scholarship at any time if satisfied that the student is not diligently pursuing the prescribed course.
8. Each scholarship will be credited directly to the student's fees account at the time of enrolment.
9. Applications should be made on the appropriate form which can be obtained from the Scholarships Office and forwarded to the Scholarships Supervisor, University of Canterbury, Private Bag 4800, Christchurch, by 14 December in the year before study is to begin.

NOTE: The current value of each scholarships is full payment of domestic tuition fees for the year of tenure.
